

Logistics




Next Steps

For Panels

- Brainstorm a topic and collaborate with your colleagues from other colleges that you wish to present with
- To prepare for registration, the primary panelist should have the following information ready:
 - Session Title; Session Description; Co-Panelist names, titles, institutions, email addresses
- During registration, the primary panelist will select the time slot
- Each institution will be responsible for their own payment
 - The primary panelist will submit their payment with the registration
 - Co-Panelists will be sent a link for payment, due upon receipt
- Payment is due from all participants to complete the registration
